ENYTB has been hosting Last Man Standing Tournaments continuously since 2002. Extra Innings became an exclusive sponsor of these tournaments in 2009. These tournaments provide teams with a fun ending to their summer baseball season. It is no doubt the single most popular event of the year with more than 60 teams participating in 2009. Depending on interest, separate LMS tournaments are run for each age and competition level on consecutive weekends in mid to late July, following the conclusion of the entry-level sanctioned tournaments in each age division.

THREE POSSIBLE FORMATS DEPENDING ON NUMBER OF ENTRIES

4 ENTRIES

PHASE I	Round Robin (3 Game Guarantee) - Play On Fri/Sat Used To Seed Semi-Final Round on Sun (Top Three Teams Qualify For Semi-Finals)
PHASE II	Two Round Single Elimination On Sunday To Determine Champion (5 Game MAX)

5 ENTRIES

PHASE I	Round Robin (4 Game Guarantee) Played On Fri/Sat/SUN - Top Two Teams Qualify For Championship Game.
PHASE II	One Round Single Elimination Championship Game On Monday (5 Game MAX)

6 ENTRIES

PHASE I	Cross Pool (3 Game Guarantee) Played On Fri/Sat - Teams in Pool A Play Teams in Pool B (non-league teams put in same pool). Overall Four Best Records (not top 2 from each pool) Advance To Sunday.
PHASE II	Seeded Two Round Single Elimination On Sunday To Determine Champion (5 Game MAX).

REGISTRATION DEADLINE/DETAILS

Online Registration Will Remain Open Through Early July

REGISTRATION - The entry fee for this tournament is \$475 (breakeven). This fee is all-inclusive i.e., it includes ump fees and baseballs for all games as well as team and player awards for the top two finishing teams. Berths are available on a direct buy-in basis only. Berths are assigned to teams in the order that payment is received, as shown on the website. Teams can register for this tournament through March 15th via their regular team registration page or up until early July via ENYTB's online open tournament registration (Tournaments > Open > Sign Up).

REFUND POLICY - (1) Any registered team unable to participate because of a conflict with advancement in an AABC/NABF/PONY sanctioned national championship tournament series shall receive a full refund. (2) Any team unable to participate for any other reason shall be entitled to a full refund IF AND ONLY IF another team from the waiting list takes its place. (3) Any 5th or 6th entrant, unable to participate for any other reason and not replaced by another team from the waiting list, shall be entitled to a refund of \$250, provided a notice of at least 72 hours is given. (4) Any 4th entrant unable to participate for any other reason and not replaced by another team from the waiting list, shall NOT be entitled to any refund.

HOSTING FORMAT - All tournament formats are played on Friday night through Sunday. The 5 team format winds up on Monday. Each tournament format requires both a primary and a secondary host site (unless primary host has two fields). Games are played at both sites on Friday and Saturday. The 6 team format may require use of a 3rd field on Friday night, depending on availability of lights etc. The 6 games on Saturday can be played on two fields, though non-host teams may have to travel to both sites to play on Saturday. The three championship round games on Sunday (both 4 team and 6 team formats) are played at the primary host site.

AWARDS - The top 2 finishing teams shall receive team championship trophies (ENYTB trademark "3-Bat, Glove & Ball" trophies) and each player on BOTH teams shall receive an individual award.
