

ENYTB'S PLAYER RELEASE LOGIC

LEAGUE STATUS : ROSTER PROTECTED PLAYER

FIRST AND LAST COMMANDMENT

Thou Shalt Not Covet (Tamper with) Thy Fellow Member's Rostered Players

DEFINITION: PROTECTED PLAYER - Any player on the roster of another ENYTB team at end of last regular season who participated in at least three league games during that season and is still on that team's ENYTB roster. Also any player legally added in the current year to the ENYTB roster of another member.

Q. What constitute's tampering?

A. ANY show of interest by ANYONE associated with an ENYTB team (including coaches, parents, friends, etc.) in a ROSTER PROTECTED player BEFORE that player has been OFFICIALLY released by his current/former club.

ENYTB PROTOCOL FOR HANDLING A FIRST CONTACT SITUATION BETWEEN ANY PLAYER AND ANY CLUB/TEAM OR PERSON ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE TEAM

On Initial Contact With Player, ENYTB Club/Team Must Determine Player's ENYTB Status i.e., Is The Player On The Roster Of Another ENYTB Team.
